Begin your journey with taking taxi from hotel to A-Ma Temple, experience the world heritage sites with the blend of Chinese and Portuguese culture. End your day amidst the enchanting scenery of Nam Van Lake. You will fully experience the history and culture of the former Portuguese settlement in Macau and the old-style community.

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9:00 **VISIT THE OLDEST TEMPLE IN MACAU: A-MA TEMPLE**
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10:00 Redating the founding of Macau itself, A-Ma Temple houses a stunning array of pavilions dedicated to various deities within its integrated complex. It perfectly blends Confucianism, Taoism, Buddhism and folk beliefs, embodying traditional Chinese culture.

10:00 **EXPLORE MACAU’S PROFOUND MARITIME BOND AT THE MARITIME MUSEUM**
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12:00 Nestled on the historic shore where the Portuguese first set foot in Macau, the museum is shaped like a grand sailing ship in Inner Harbor. It showcases ancient fishing traditions, coastal life, and the rich maritime history of China and Portugal.

12:00 **TASTE THE LOCAL FOOD AT SAN HONG CAFÉ**
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13:00 Located in the bustling streets, this family-run restaurant has simple, nostalgic décor. It serves authentic local food; its signature Macau Chicken Rice comes with crispy chicken legs, coconut curry sauce and curry fried rice.

13:00 **DISCOVER THE MANDARIN'S HOUSE, A BLEND OF CHINESE & WESTERN STYLES**
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15:00 Built before 1869, this traditional Chinese residential compound was the former home of prominent Chinese literary luminary Zheng Guanying. It features classic courtyard houses with an elegant blend of Chinese and Western architectural details.

15:00 **PILGRIMAGE TO ST. JOSEPH’S SEMINARY CHURCH**
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16:00 Established in 1728, this historic seminary, together with St. Paul’s College, served as the core base for missionary work in China, Japan and the surrounding regions. Adjacent to it lies St. Joseph’s Church, erected in 1758, a stellar exemplar of Baroque architecture in China.

16:00 **TRY THE TRADITIONAL BAKERY: JIM SAI PADARIAS**
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16:30 Jim Sai Padarias is a local bakery with fresh bread daily. Serving the best Fried Sugar Puffs in Macau, having a light and fluffy center hence its less dense than doughnuts and it’s similarly coated with sugar powder. It’s the perfect afternoon tea treat.

16:30 **EXPLORE THE ST. LAWRENCE’S CHURCH**
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17:30 Built in the mid-16th century, it is one of Macau’s three oldest churches. Perched on Macau’s southern coastline with sweeping sea views, it was where Portuguese sailors’ families prayed for their safe return, hence named Feng Shun Tang (Hall of the Soothing Winds).

17:30 **SOAK IN THE LAKE VIEW OF NAM VAN LAKE**
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18:30 Nam Van Lake is the perfect spot to sit and relax. Boasting lovely small boats and lush green mini-islands, the lake treats you to golden sunlight filtering through as the sun dips gently over the horizon if you visit at the right moment.

18:30 **TASTE THE MACANESE FOOD AT HENRI'S GALLEY**
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20:30 Henri’s Galley is a traditional and family-friendly restaurant in Sai Van Lake with outdoor seating. Signature must-try dishes include African chicken—tender chicken pieces soaked in red chili, coconut milk, garlic, paprika.
