



LIVELY NEIGHBOURHOODS' JOURNEY AT OLD TAIPA VILLAGE

Old Taipa Village boasts Macau's best-preserved Portuguese architecture. Begin your journey with a resort complimentary shuttle bus to reach Old Taipa Village, spend a day for exploring, tasting street food, and buying souvenirs for family and friends. Stroll among the colourful Portuguese buildings and feel the nostalgic European style. This will leave you with satisfied taste buds and unforgettable memories.

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12:30 – 13:30	LUNCH IN LOCAL STYLE AT SEI KEE CAFÉ Enjoy lunch at Sei Kee Café, founded in 1965. It brews coffee and milk tea with traditional clay pots and charcoal, a rare practice in Macau. Other signature dish is deep fried bread cubes with condensed milk, peanut butter, and biscuit crumbs.
13:30 – 14:00	VISIT PAK TAI TEMPLE IN TAIPA Step into history at Taipa's Pak Tai Temple, a landmark with over 160 years of history verified by an ancient inscribed stele. Each year on the 3rd day of the 3rd lunar month, traditional Chinese opera is staged in a mat-shed during the lively Pak Tai Festival.
14:00 – 15:30	SOUVENIR HUNTING AT RUA DO CUNHA O-MOON GIFT SHOP O-Moon is a unique souvenir shop showcasing Macau's culture. Its blue-and-white products blend Portuguese tiles and Chinese porcelain designs, including postcards, coasters, stationery, and accessories. PASTELARIA FONG KEI Established in 1902, Fong Kei is a beloved traditional souvenir food shop with century-old décor. The handmakes Chinese cakes and biscuits using original recipes. A standout is their pork biscuit: pork biscuit is rich, crispy, and non-greasy.
15:30 – 16:30	EXPLORE THE FIRECRACKER HISTORY IN IEC LONG FIRECRACKER FACTORY The firecracker manufacturing industry was vital to 20th century Macau's economy. Nearly 100 year's old Iec Long Firecracker Factory preserves the original layout and environment of the former production structures, and a cultural and creative products' souvenir shop.
16:30 – 17:15	TASTE THE LOCAL STREET FOOD AT RUA DE REGEDOR WING KEE BEEF OFFAL For authentic old Macau flavor, try Wing Kee Beef Offal. A fourth-generation street food staple with over 70 years of history. It serves tender, aromatic beef offal in secret sauce. Add curry sauce, fish balls and white radishes for an unforgettable taste. LEMONCELLO GELATO As an original Macau brand, Lemoncello offers light, healthy gelato with less cream and egg yolk. Their namesake Lemoncello flavor bursts with the fresh, tangy taste of real lemon juice. Single to triple scoops available to delight your taste buds.
17:15 – 18:00	CHECK IN HOTSPOT AT CALÇADA DO QUARTEL Lining the Calçada do Quartel, eye-catching buildings adorned with vibrant graffiti create a lively backdrop for an array of specialty eateries and creative shops. This colorful alley, with its distinctive cafes and snack bars, has become a popular photo hotspot in the area.
18:00 – 19:00	EXPLORE TAIPA HOUSES MUSEUM As one of Macau's top eight sights, the Taipa Houses are a charming representation of Portuguese architecture. These five distinctive green villas with the nearby church and garden, they form a picturesque, iconic landmark along Avenida da Praia.
19:00 – 21:00	ENJOY DINNER AT CASA MAQUISTA Nestled in an iconic Macanese house at the Taipa Houses-Museum, Casa Maquista serves one of the world's earliest fusion cuisines – Macanese dishes in a century-old mansion with Cotai Strip views. Must try the Bacalhau Enrolado em Couve.
