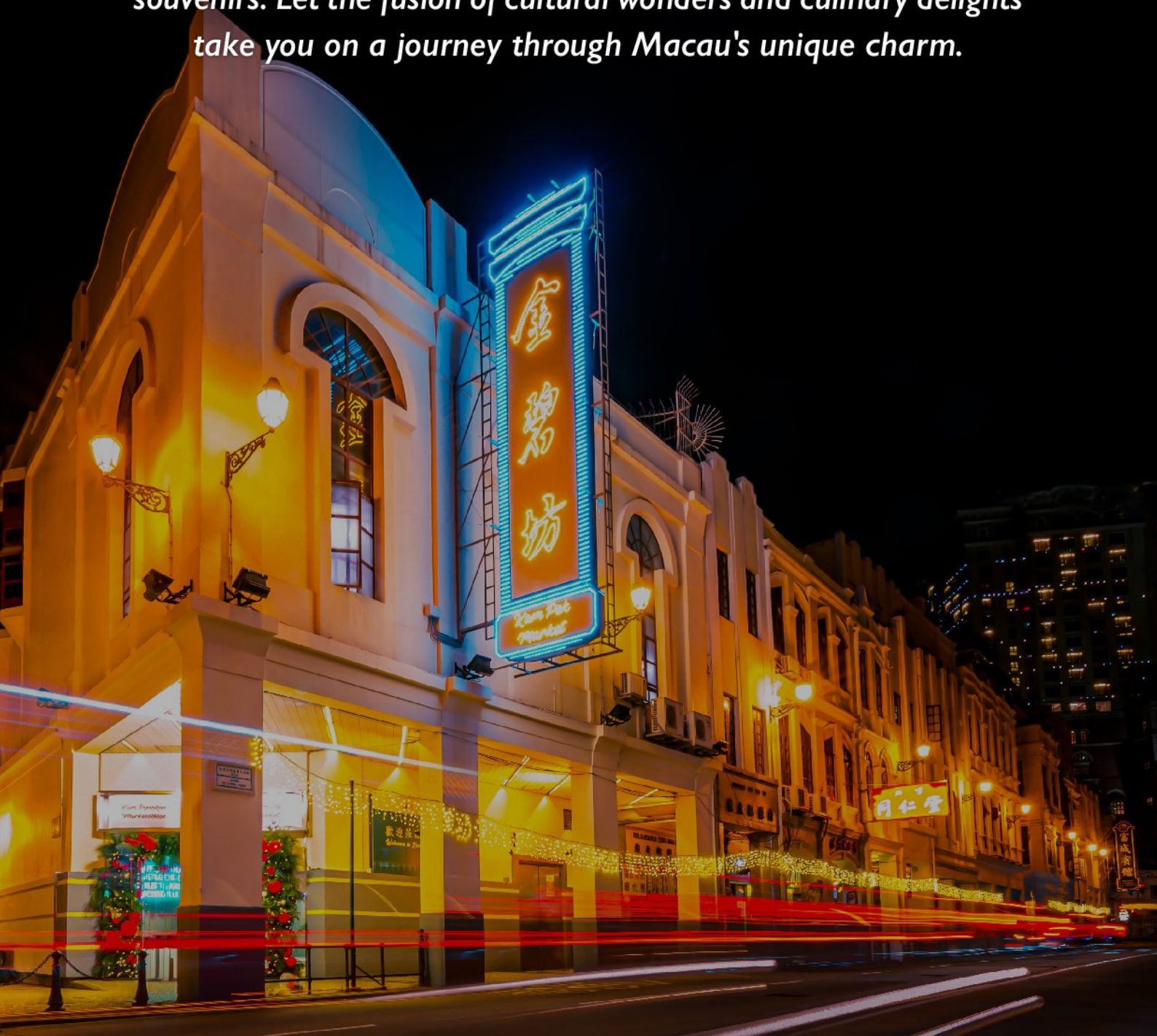


# IMMERSIVE SAN MA LOU JOURNEY

## IMMERSIVE SAN MA LOU JOURNEY

10:00 – 11:00	<b>VISIT THE LEGEND GRAND LISBOA HOTEL</b> Take a short walk on our sister property which located in the Central Business District, which is an iconic building set in Macau. The grand lobby features precious antiques and exquisite art, embodying timeless elegance.
11:00 – 11:30	<b>VISIT GENERAL POST OFFICE BUILDING</b> Visit the historical three-storey building featured with European style, there is a bell tower on the top which reports the time with music. You can buy your favorite stamps & postcards and mail to your beloved ones, making your visit more meaningful.
11:30 – 12:30	<b>EXPLORE SENADO SQUARE</b> Take a short walk on the Senado Square which name came from the old City's Council, the "Leal Senado" Building. This area has been Macau's city center for centuries. Feature with iconic Portuguese black-and-white pavements highlight the city's unique heritage.
12:30 – 14:00	<b>LUNCH AT KAM PEK MARKET</b> Enjoy lunch at Kam Pek Market which formerly known as Casino Kam Pek. This three-storey heritage building retains its restored façade and artistic interior, now a popular culinary spot offering Macanese and international cuisines.
14:00 – 14:45	<b>EXPLORE HERITAGE EXHIBITION OF A TRADITIONAL PAWNSHOP BUSINESS</b> Tak Seng On Pawnshop was established in 1917, is the oldest pawnshop building in Macau with a relatively complete structure. It was now being converted into a museum, afforded the visiting public a glimpse at the heyday of the pawnshop industry.
14:45 – 15:15	<b>VISIT HONG KUNG TEMPLE</b> Hong Kung Temple honors Buddhist and Taoist deities, where locals pray for safety and blessings. Legend says a wooden statue of Duke Hong drifted ashore; the community built the temple in 1860 to enshrine it.
15:15 – 16:15	<b>FIND THE "OLD MACAU" IN RUA DOS ERVANARIOS</b> It is one of the oldest and unique streets in Macau. Blending traditional incense and antique shops with modern cafes and creative boutiques, this heritage area preserves local industries while evolving into a vibrant cultural destination for visitors.
16:15 – 17:15	<b>AFTERNOON TEA AT YI SHUN (MACAU)</b> For a taste of tradition, visit Yi Shun, a century-old Macau dessert shop with classic nostalgic charm. Its most famous creation is the Double-Skin Steamed Milk Pudding—boasts silky texture and delicate milk skin.
17:15 – 18:30	<b>SOUVENIR SHOPPING AT PASTELARIA CHI HEONG</b> Purchase the signature local souvenir food to your friends and family at Chi Heong which has a history spanning more than 80 years in Macau. The shop offers a wide range of pickled fruits, egg biscuits and egg rolls, a beloved local childhood taste.
18:30 – 20:30	<b>DINNER AT GRAND LISBOA HOTEL - THE EIGHT</b> Go back to Grand Lisboa Macau, it showcases Macau's rich culinary heritage with diverse dining, from casual dining to MICHELIN Star restaurant. Dining at The Eight, a two-MICHELIN-starred restaurant serving a unique dining atmosphere with traditional Cantonese cuisine.
